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CHAPTER-V

SUMMARY CONCLUSIO AND RECOMMENDATION

5.1 Summary

Sports have become an important part of this nation's culture as well as of other culture throughout the world. It captures newspaper headlines, holds television viewers attention, and produces millions of dollar revenue for entrepreneur as on impact on international affairs, advertisers target large percentage of their promotional budget to buy airtime during sorting event to cell their worlds. A state level Primary School Education Board for which provision already existed in the Primary Education Act of 1973, has been established. The Board is supposed to exercise jurisdictional authority on the District Primary School Councils, the objective is as much to decentralize as to democratize the primary education system." The sports activities can also help students to perform better in academics. The daily physical activities help students to improve their memory and refresh their minds. If sports are part of daily routine, then students can perform better in their academics. Because students become physically and mentally healthy, so this will help them to focus on their studies.

The summary of the present study was how adequate and facilities are the children's playgrounds in the primary schools of East Medinipur district. See what equipment is available for primary school children to play.

For this study, researcher visited thirty primary schools in Purba Medinipur District. Length and width were measured in thirty primary school fields. Tape and score sheets were used for this research. The primary school play equipment was looked after and the head teachers helped us a lot.

According to "Indian standard recommendations for basic requirements of school buildings", every primary school should have a field with an area of 4000m². We used mean and S.d to find the area of the playground.

In Purba Medinipur district no one primary school have their minimum playground area according to "INDIAN STANDARD RECOMMENDATIONS FOR BASIC

REQUIREMENTS OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS" many recommended governments aided school run from very old time without any ground facilities in this school children always spend their time in class room situation without refreshment.

Table two shows that Mean and S.D of playground area in primary school of Purba Medinipur district was $317 \text{ m}^2 \pm 251 \text{ m}^2$ and table also shows that the recommended playground area in primary school according to "Indian standard recommendations for basic requirements of school buildings".

5.2 Conclusion

Based on the result of the present study and within the limitation mentioned earlier, the following conclusion may be drawn.

1. According to the ground facility in government aided primary school of Purba Medinipur district for the children are not enough due to unknown reason.
2. Minimum sports equipment facility for children in primary school of Purba Medinipur district are not supplied by the government or the school authorities.
3. According to the principal of physical education sports psychology it is establish that the physical education and sports curriculum is very essential of physical education primary school children, but in Purba Medinipur district this essential principal are highly violated in each and every government aided primary school.

5.3 RECOMMENDATION

1. Similar studies may be conducted with upper primary, high school and college level institution.
2. Similar study may be conducted one another district of west Bengal as well as other state.
3. A study of similar nature may be conducted on government school and primary school.
4. Study may be conducted on other educational parameter like sanitization, urinal facilities, class room Etc.
