workshops were conducted by experts from the Department of Botany and Physiology, providing valuable insights into the ecological aspects of water conservation and the physiological impact of water scarcity.

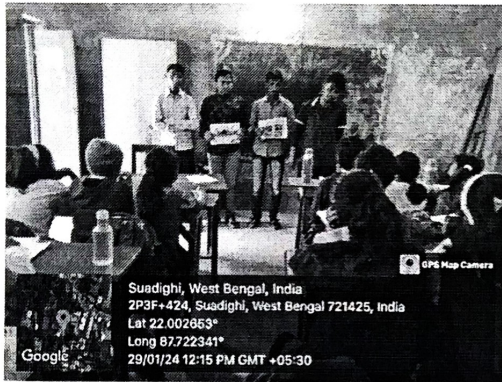

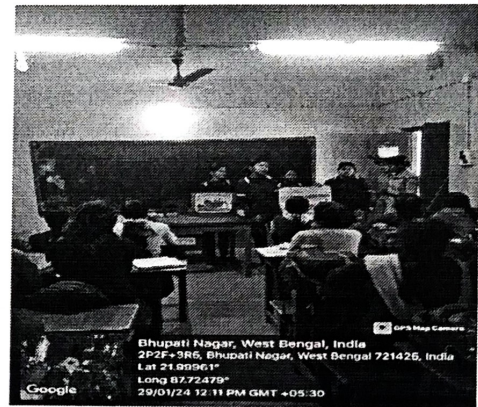

Interactive Sessions: Open forums allowed community members to share their concerns and brainstorm solutions, fostering a sense of collective responsibility towards water conservation.


Collaborative Efforts:
