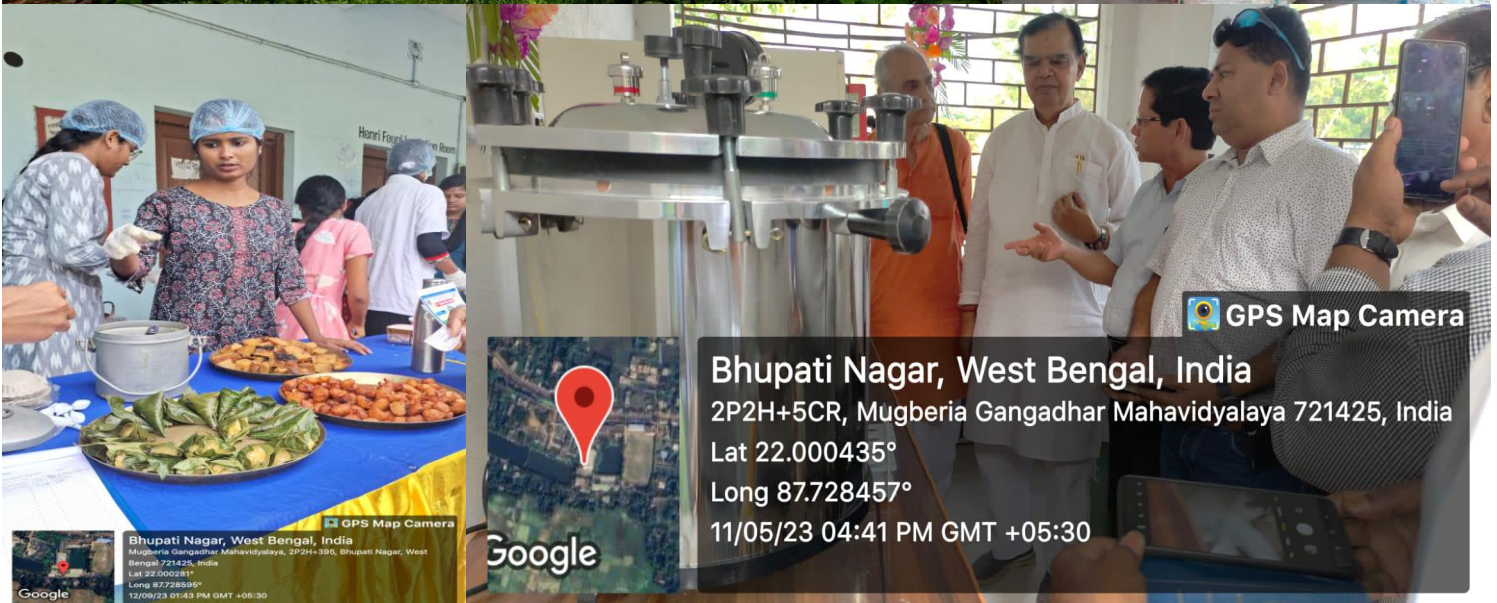

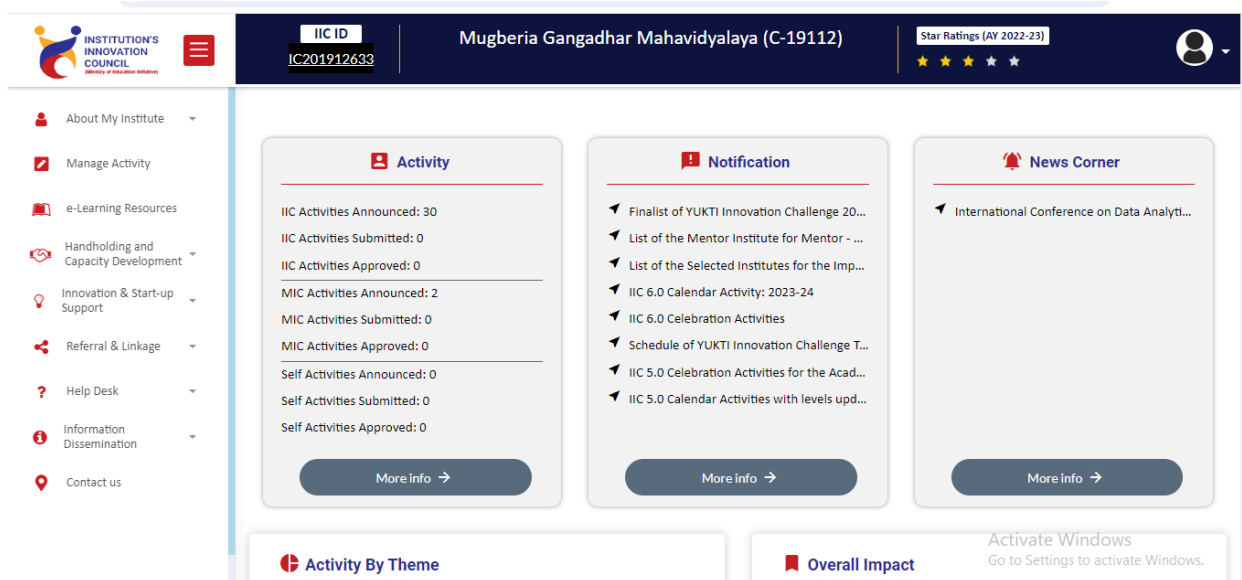

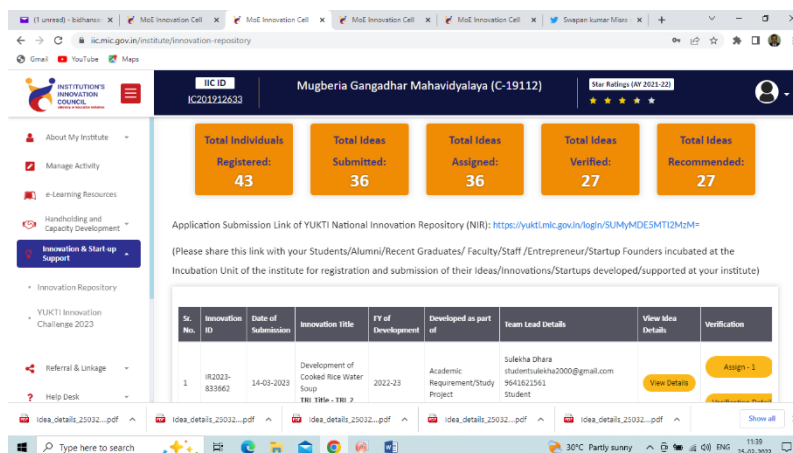


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4. Intra institutional idea competition through YUKTI-NIR dated 20/03/23

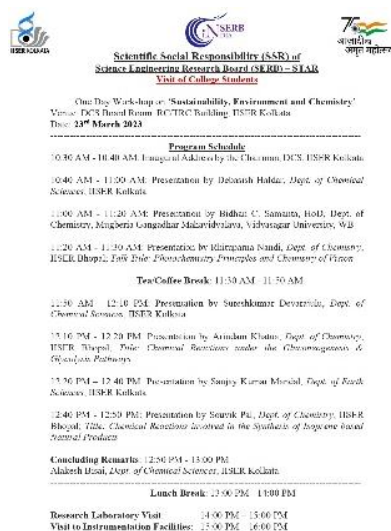
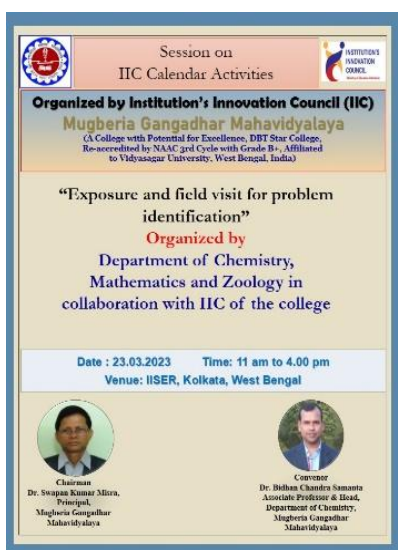


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5. Exposure and field visit to IISER Kolkata for problem identification dated 23.03.23

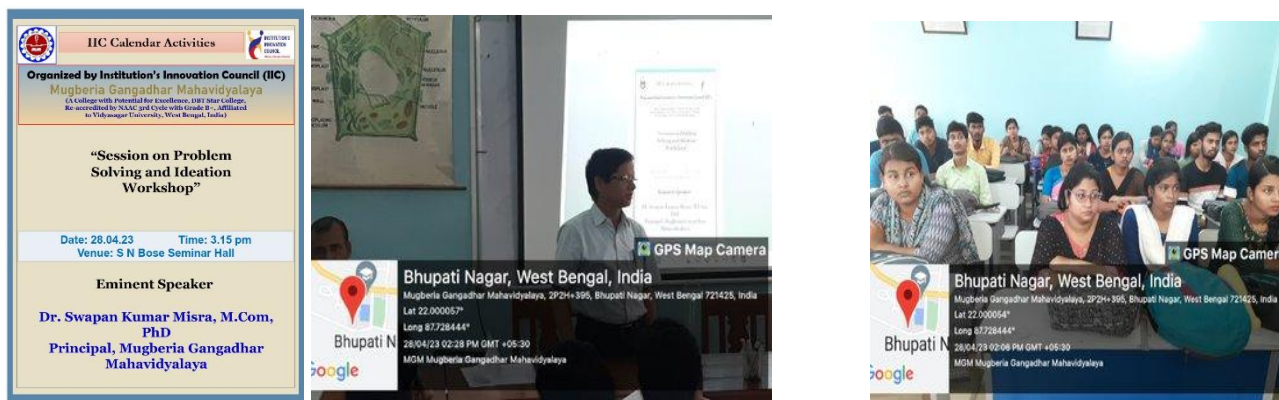


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6. Session on Problem Solving and Ideation Workshop Dated 28.04.2023

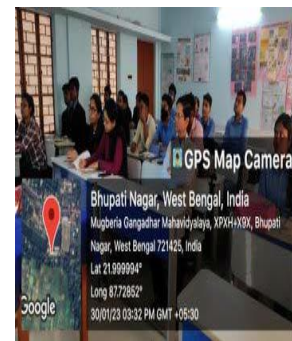


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7. Entrepreneurship and Innovation as Career Opportunity dated 30/01/2023

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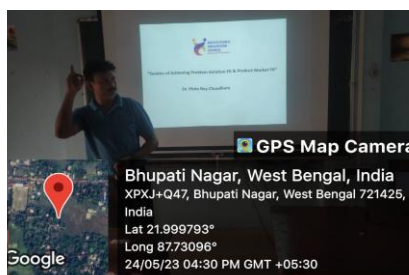
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11. Workshop on “Achieving Problem-Solution Fit & Product Market Fit” dated 24.05.2023

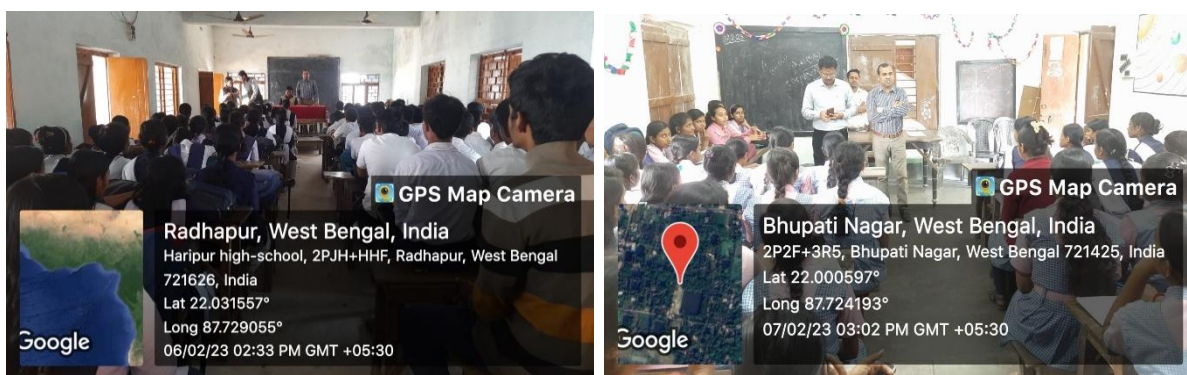

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14. Organising Innovation & Entrepreneurship Outreach Program in Schools during 07/02/23 – 10/02/23

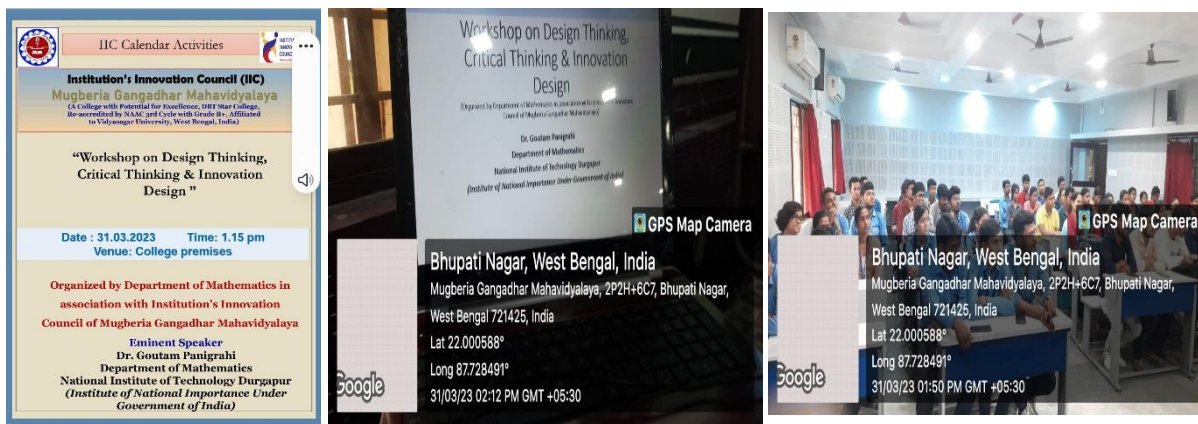

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16. Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) and IP management for start-up (Q III) dated 30.06.2023

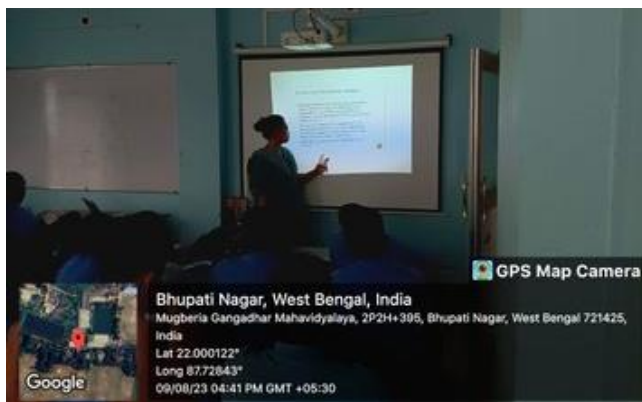

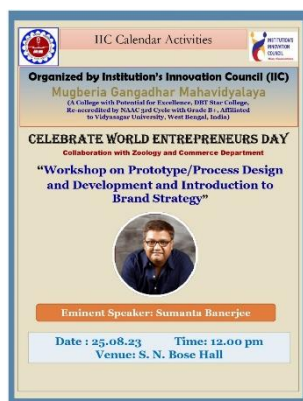


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20. Workshop on Prototype/Process Design (Q IV) dated 25.08.2023

Bio Fertilizer





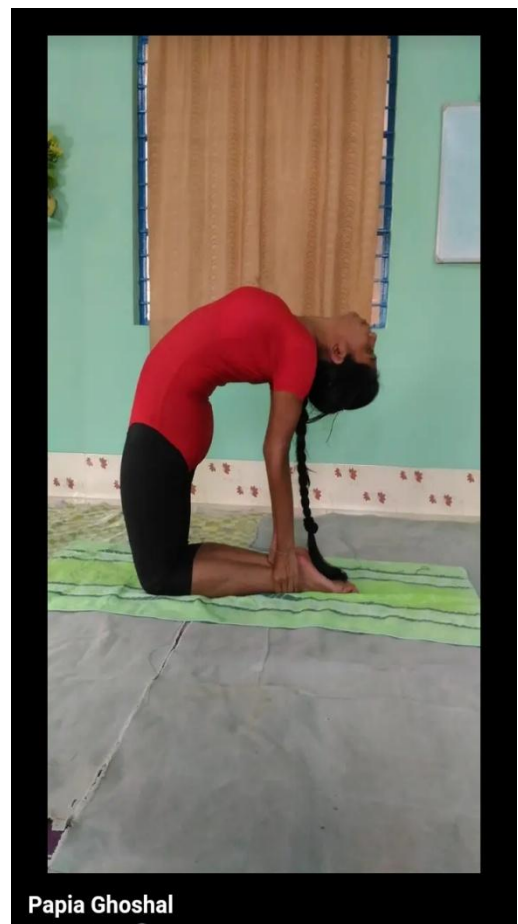
