Purba Medinipur, 721425 West Bengal, India which expression shall include their subsidiaries, branch offices, associations, administrator, legal heirs, group institutions, etc.

1. BACKGROUND:

- 1.1. IPQuad, an Indian intellectual property research and analytical service firm that values its customers' time and provides knowledgeable and resourceful business assets to assist in supporting innovators, entrepreneurs, and researchers globally.
- 1.2. Mugberia Gangadhar Mahavidyalaya was established on 2nd of July, 1964 as a co-education college in Purba Medinipur District (Erstwhile Midnapore District) after the name of Medinipurs pride - Late Raisaheb Gangadhar Nanda - a great lover and patron of education. The college is the only educational institution in the wide Bhagwanpur-II block, which is located in a culturally diverse area. - 1.4. Whereas, MGM is getting associated with IPQuad for developing innovation and research initiatives and streamlining existing IP processes, if any with the following primary objectives:



- 1.4.1. Facilitate in protecting innovations with all the services mentioned in the proposal and mutually agreed upon (Annexure 1)
- 1.4.2. Facilitate in the patent prosecution cycle from patent searching, drafting, and patent filing to post-grant procedures
- 1.4.3. Provide complete IP management
- 1.4.4. Provide other IP filings (Trademark, Design, Copyright, etc.)
- 1.4.5. IPQuad will look out for all end-to-end IP activities of MGM

The two parties to the MoU, with the intention of both being legally bound, accept the following terms and conditions:

2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF IPQUAD:

- 2.1. To act as a resource body to handle the complete IP service activities pertaining to MGM and its clients.
- 2.2. To act as a resource body for rendering research & intellectual property training programs, conducting seminars and workshops including the development of program structure and module development.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MGM:

- 3.2. All other support and assistance that would be required in seamlessly carrying on all the activities of IPQuad Partners.

4. PAYMENT PROCEDURE

- 4.1. IPQuad will raise an invoice according to the type of project (pricing in Annexure 1s).
- 4.2. IPQuad will raise an invoice for the government fee in advance and any government filings or submissions will be done within 2-3 working days of receiving the fee in IPQuad's accounts.

4.4. MGM shall make the payment towards the invoice raised by IPQuad within 15 days of receipt of the invoice. In case, the payment is delayed for more than 15 days then an interest of 1.5% per month, on the invoiced amount shall be applicable.

4.5. All invoices will be generated as per the mutually agreed price. It is to be noted that the fees mentioned in Annexure 1 are exclusive of GST Tax charges and Online Payment Charges.

6. LIABILITIES

6.1. MGM shall not, however, be liable for:

- a. any payments of claims by employees or associates of IPQuad.
- b. discharging any financial commitments made by IPQuad outside the scope of this MoU and without consulting MGM
- c. any suit on account of demands and other laws by IPQuad which have no nexus with the object of the MoU being entered into.

6.2. IPQuad shall not, however, be liable for:

- a. any payments of claims by employees or associates of MGM.
- b. discharging any financial commitments made by MGM outside the scope of this MoU and without consulting IPQuad
- c. any suit on account of demands and other laws by MGM which have no nexus with the object of the MoU being entered into.

7. BREACH OF MoU:

Both parties to the MoU will have the right to terminate the MoU, in case the terms and conditions of the MoU are violated by either party, by giving written notice of 3 months to the violating party.

8. AMENDMENT TO THE MoU

The obligations of MGM and IPQuad have been outlined in this MoU. However, during the operation of the MoU, circumstances may arise that call for alteration or modifications of this MoU. These modifications/alterations will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing.


9. PERIOD OF VALIDITY

This MoU shall be initially valid for **3 years**, from the date of signing the MoU, and to be subsequently **renewed after every 3 years, based on the commitment of projects at the end of that particular financial year.**



10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute arising with regard to any aspect of this MoU shall be settled through mutual consultations and agreements by the parties to the MoU.





SWAPAN KUMAR MISRA, PRINCIPAL (name & designation), of the SECOND PART.

The THSC and MUGGERIA GANGADHAR MAHAVIDYALAYA are hereinafter individually referred to as "Party" and collectively as "Parties".

THSC is a Sector Skill Council for the Tourism & Hospitality Sector functioning under the aegis of the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) supported by leading industry players in India with an aim to create an eco-system for quality vocational education in the Tourism & Hospitality Sector and allied sector. It aims to meet the entire value chain's requirements of trained manpower (in both quantity and quality terms) across all levels on a sustained and evolving basis. Formed with the motive of "by the industry for the industry" and will cater to all the sub-sectors of the industry, namely, Hotels, Tour Operators, Food Service Restaurants, Facilities Management and Cruise Lines.

MUGGERIA GANGADHAR MAHAVIDYALAYA offers B.Voc. and other courses, as regulated with UGC and/or other authorities, to its students/candidates.

WHEREAS Second Party seeks to incorporate and apply the certification of "Skill India" under the aegis of NSDC rules and regulations, to the candidates qualifying from its institution(college);

AND WHEREAS the first party agrees to certify the candidates of the Second Party under the "Skill India" programme as mandated by the NSDC.

NOW THEREFORE, THESE PRESENTS WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Term of the MOU

The MOU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties hereto.

- b) This MOU shall continue in full force and effect up to 3 years from the date of signing i.e. up to 1st AUGUST 2025. Both Parties can mutually decide to further extend the MOU if they wish to continue their alliance further by an extension agreement in writing.



2. Rules and Responsibilities of the Second Party:-

SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR E-WASTE MANAGEMENT

The Agreement is entered into at Kolkata on this 25 day of June, 2021

By and Between

Mulladek Recycling Private Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Act 2013 having its registered office at 4, D.L. Khola Road, Flat No B-401, 4th Floor, Kolkata-700025, West Bengal, India (hereinafter referred to as First Party) which expression shall unless contrary to and or repugnant to the context mean and include its successors representative and permitted assigns through Mr. Manoj Kumar to enter into and sign this Agreement for and on behalf of the First Party

AND

Mughertha Ganapathi Mahavidyalaya established in 1954 is one of the oldest colleges in Purba Medinipur district, West Bengal. India. It offers undergraduate courses in arts, commerce and sciences. It is affiliated to Vidyasagar University having its premises at Mughertha, Mughertha Road, Bhupali Nagar, Purba Medinipur West Bengal-721425. There is after referred to as Second Party which expression shall unless contrary to and or repugnant to the context mean and include its successors representative and permitted assigns through Dr Swapan Kumar Misra (Principal) to enter into and sign this Agreement for and on behalf of the Second Party.

A) First Party is a registered Producer Responsibility Organization (PRO) vide The Registration No. B-28016432U (P)ROU/TA/MW-III Division dated 12.11.2018 and it is authorized to undertake activities prescribed to Producer Responsibility Organizations.

B) The Second Party in compliance of E-Waste Management Rules, 2016 & 2022 delegates the responsibility for management of their Electronic Waste except liquid waste

New, being that, this Agreement witnesses the following terms & conditions to be performed by both the parties to the Agreement.

- 1 The First Party has agreed to pick up, transport, carry and recycle/dispose of the E-Waste from the second party as per the norms prescribed by the Government authorities from time to time.
- 2 The First Party has agreed to make available Utilization Certificate confirming that E-Waste provided by the Second party to the First Party has been recycled/disposed of as per the norms prescribed by the Government Authorities within 60 days of the pick up of E-Waste.
- 3 The second party will sign required documents to acknowledge that E-Waste has been handed over to the First Party.
- 4 This agreement will be in force for a period of Three (03) years (25.06.2021 - 24.06.2024) from the date of execution of this Agreement and can be renewed at the end of every period by mutual consent.
- 5 The second party is expected to generate minimum 500 kgs of E-Waste annually during each contractual term.
- 6 The First Party shall provide compliance documents such as Form 2, Form 3, Query letters from PCB or any other document required as per government norms and shall be annual return for the respective year to the state pollution control board on a chargeable basis of per location annually as records of e-waste movement from the premises of the second party to first party as and when applicable.
- 7 The Second Party will accumulate all E-Waste and inform to the first party once reasonable volume (approx. 300 kgs minimum) has accumulated. The pickups confirmed by the Second Party will be carried out on a priority basis within Five days from the date of request.
- 8 The Second party has agreed to handover the E-Waste items, the details of which are mentioned here below to the first party on "as is where is basis".
 - a The first party will dispose off such equipment and specifically agreed that they will charge the second party towards the disposal of E-Waste as shown in ANNEXURE 2.
- 9 The first party will pay in case of the items in ANNEXURE 1. Any monies payable/receivable by the First party will be identified and settled by 7th of preceding month for the current month or the subsequent months as may be mutually decided from time to time. Applicable GST on such items will be additional.
- 10 The second party's responsibility will cease once electronic waste has been handed over to the First Party's per clause 3 above. Thereafter, no liability would accrue to the Second party on account of e-waste.
- 11 The renewal of the contract is chargeable at the end of the tenure/period and the documentation formalities shall be done by the First Party within 30-45 days prior to the date of agreement termination.
- 12 Records & data of the e-waste material procured will be maintained and transparently

13. The Second Party has agreed that the general waste such as municipal solid waste will not be included in the E-Waste.

14. It is clearly agreed that all the E-waste procured by or at the possession of the second party will be exclusively managed by the first party on per the terms and conditions specified above.

15. The First Party shall conduct an Announcement Session at the premises of the Second Party for generating awareness about the benefits and process of e-waste recycling.

a. The second party then shall prepare and share with first party an Announcement report to be submitted the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.







Terms & Conditions for the DBT Support For strengthening of Life Science and biotechnology education and training at undergraduate level to colleges under star college scheme of DBT.

1. The programme will receive financial support initially for a period of 3 years. Further continuation of support will be based on evaluation of the programme. After a period of 3 years, the colleges would be eligible for consideration of Star College status based on evaluation by the expert committee. Decision of expert committee will be final. DBT will measure progress by following parameters

- Substantial increase in proportion of 'hands on' experimental work by students
- Increased access of undergraduate students to laboratory and bioinformatics infrastructure
- Improvement in access to life sciences related journals
- Summer schools
- Percentage of students pursuing life science as a career
- Measure effectiveness on the basis of feedback from students, faculty

2. The Department does not encourage starting of biotechnology teaching programme at undergraduate level. The programme should lay emphasis on strengthening biotechnology component in existing life sciences courses and practical training, industry exposure to students, upgradation of faculty skills by organizing training for faculty

3. The grant for equipment provided by DBT will be used for purchase of minor equipment (cost not exceeding ~ 1.00 lakh) routinely used for classroom teaching for students. 

BAJAJ FINSERV LIMITED, a company registered under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, having its registered office at Bajaj Auditorium Complex, Mundra, Pune Road, Pune 411 035.

AND

BAJAJ FINANCE LIMITED, a company registered under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, having its registered office at Akurdi Pune 411 035.

Through President (Legal and Taxation) - Bajaj Finserv Limited

(Bajaj Finserv Limited and Bajaj Finance Limited hereinafter referred to as "FINSERV")

The expressions "PARTNER INSTITUTE" and "FINSERV" shall collectively be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

WHEREAS

- A. PARTNER INSTITUTE established in 1964 by The society of Mughera Gangadhar Mahavidyalaya is affiliated to Vels Institute of Management Studies.
- B. Bajaj Finserv Limited is the holding company for financial services businesses of the Bajaj Group.
- C. Bajaj Finance Limited is a Non-Banking Finance Company registered with Reserve Bank of India.
- D. FINSERV, as part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities, desires to create employment opportunities for educated youth in the Banking, Finance and Insurance Sector through a customized training programme encompassing product knowledge, communication and other soft skills, which is expected to benefit fresh graduates, especially those belonging to economically weaker sections of the society.
- E. FINSERV, in partnership with some of the leading educational institutes, has designed and developed a customized programme viz. Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance (hereinafter referred to as CPBFI).
- F. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has expressed its willingness to partner with FINSERV to conduct CPBFI for its students and alumni, on terms and conditions set out herein below.
- F. FINSERV has accepted the offer of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and agreed to partner with the PARTNER INSTITUTE for conducting CPBFI, on terms and conditions set out below.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS UNDER:

1. Purpose/Objective of CPBFI:

The objective of CPBFI is to impart practical knowledge and essential skills to final year graduation students and fresh graduates, especially those belonging to economically weaker sections of the society, with a view to create employment opportunities for them in the Banking, Finance and Insurance Companies.

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2. Scope of CPBT:

- a. FINSERV has appointed different training institutes as Official Training Partners for conducting CPBT (hereinafter referred to as CPBT-Official Training Partners).
- b. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE, through one of the CPBT-Official Training Partners, shall conduct for the eligible students and alumni of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, a Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance viz. CPBT, covering/including overview and product knowledge relevant for roles in bank, NBFC, life insurance and general insurance companies, communication and other workplace skills. CPBT shall be conducted through classroom training [hereinafter referred to as CPBT-CLASSROOM], online training [hereinafter referred to as CPBT-ONLINE] or a combination of classroom and online training [hereinafter referred to as CPBT-BLENDED].

3. Responsibilities of the Parties:

- a. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for providing necessary infrastructure facilities for conducting awareness about CPBT and its potential benefits for the prospective students. FINSERV shall, if requested by PARTNER INSTITUTE, at its discretion, support the awareness campaigns by participating in the student meetings, parent meetings and design of publicity materials such as posters, leaflets, etc.
- b. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for providing necessary infrastructure facilities for conducting classroom sessions of CPBT-CLASSROOM and CPBT-BLENDED, specifically (a) one class room, equipped with a projector, a sound system and a white board with a seating capacity of at least 45 students, (b) one computer room, equipped with computers having MS Office software and high-speed internet connection, with a seating capacity of at least 25 students, for conducting the online assessment tests (c) one assembly hall with a capacity of around 60 persons and 3 interview rooms, for one day per batch, for conducting CPBT HR Workshop. PARTNER INSTITUTE shall also provide basic stationery required for training purposes such as marker pens, chart sheets, chalks, etc.
- c. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall appoint a Coordinator for every CPBT batch, with following responsibilities:
 - a. To motivate and encourage students to extract maximum benefit from CPBT
 - b. To provide necessary support to the CPBT Official Training Partner for planning and conducting the program.
 - c. To conduct offline pre assessment and post assessment tests for every batch
 - d. To ensure that the classes are conducted as per pre-defined schedule.
 - e. To ensure that all students are regularly attending the classes.
 - f. To maintain daily attendance of students.
 - g. To attend few classes as an observer and provide feedback to FINSERV about the training quality.
 - h. To ensure discipline and good conduct from the students.
 - i. To support FINSERV team to conduct CPBT HR Workshop for every batch.
 - j. To submit required college information as per Annexure 3 to FINSERV coordinator.
- d. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue an appointment letter to the Coordinator as per format prescribed in Annexure 4 of this MOU. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit the appointment letter, duly authorized by the Principal of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and accepted by the Coordinator, to FINSERV before commencement of every CPBT Batch.
- e. FINSERV shall be responsible to design and continuously improve the CPBT programme structure, including adding or deleting courses, changing pedagogy or modifications to the programme duration.



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- vi. FINSERV shall be responsible to arrange faculty, with requisite expertise and experience, through any of its CPBFI Official Training Partners. FINSERV shall provide necessary details of the concerned CPBFI Official Training Partner to the PARTNER INSTITUTE at least 2 weeks before start of every batch. FINSERV shall be responsible to arrange the online training platform for conducting CPBFI ONLINE and CPBFI (B/N)DIO.
- vii. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for award of "Certificate of Completion" at the completion of CPBFI to all successful candidates who meet eligibility criteria viz. requisite attendance and credits in the examinations conducted during CPBFI.
- viii. FINSERV, as part of its CSR, shall bear the full cost of faculty deployed by its CPBFI Official Training Partner, to ensure that CPBFI is affordable to students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society.
- ix. FINSERV along with its chosen academic partner/s, shall conduct an online examination at the end of CPBFI. Only students who pass this examination and have requisite attendance shall be eligible to receive the "Certificate of Completion". This examination shall be in addition to all other examinations conducted by the CPBFI Official Training Partner during CPBFI.
- x. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall display the FINSERV name and logo prominently in all marketing and publicity material, notices for students and all other internal and external communications, in paper form or otherwise, relating to CPBFI.
- xi. Any other use of FINSERV brand names by the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall require prior written consent from FINSERV.
- xii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall provide to FINSERV, necessary information about all the students of CPBFI, in the format specified by FINSERV in Annexure 1. FINSERV shall be free to contact the students directly for the purpose of monitoring the impact of CPBFI and the career progression of students.
- xiii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not conduct CPBFI or a programme with identical course structure except in partnership with FINSERV.
- xiv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be solely responsible to comply with regulations of University Grants Commission or any other authority regulating educational activities in India. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that FINSERV shall not have any liability including monetary or otherwise, in the event of any regulatory action taken against the PARTNER INSTITUTE in respect of conducting this programme. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to fully compensate FINSERV in case an action is taken against FINSERV by any such regulatory authority in respect of conduct of CPBFI by the PARTNER INSTITUTE under this MOU.
- xv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be solely responsible for payment of GST or any other taxes that may be applicable, in respect of fees collected by the PARTNER INSTITUTE for CPBFI and FINSERV shall not have any liability towards the same. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that FINSERV shall not have any liability, monetary or otherwise, in the event of any action is taken against the PARTNER INSTITUTE by any tax authorities. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to fully compensate FINSERV in case any action is taken against FINSERV by any such tax authority in respect of conduct of CPBFI by the PARTNER INSTITUTE under this MOU.
- xvi. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit the information specified in Annexure 3 before commencement of every batch to FINSERV.

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4. Batch Strength

The parties agree that, each batch shall consist of minimum 30 and maximum 60 students. FINESEV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE may mutually decide to start a batch with less than 30 students.

5. Term of the MOU

The term of this MOU is for a period commencing from signing of this MOU till end of March 31, 2024, except Clause (xiii) and Clause 14, which shall continue to be in force for a further period of 3 years from the date of termination of this MOU. The parties may decide to further extend the term of this MOU by mutual consent on such terms and conditions as may be agreed between them.

6. Course Fees

- i. PARTNER INSTITUTE shall charge a non-refundable fee of Rs. 3,000 (Rupees one thousand only) plus applicable GST and other taxes, to each of the students of CPBI towards the course fees. The fee payable by each student shall not be less than Rs. 1,000 (Rupees one thousand only) plus applicable taxes and shall not exceed Rs. 3,000 (Rupees three thousand) plus applicable taxes. The fees specified here shall be valid for two years from signing of this MOU. The fees shall be reviewed on completion of this period and parties may mutually agree to revise the same from time to time.

- ii. On successful completion of every batch (i.e. if the overall attendance of the students is in excess of 75%) of CPBH-CLASSROOM and CPBH-BLENDED, FINESEV shall pay an amount of Rs. 500 (Rupees Five Hundred only) per student to the PARTNER INSTITUTE as a fee subsidy. The fee subsidy shall be paid by FINESEV within 2 weeks from completion of every batch and submission of bank account information as per Annexure 3. The method for calculating the overall attendance in respect of CPBH batches, is included in Annexure 2.

- iii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to suitably remunerate the coordinator and other staff members for their effort towards successful conduct of CPBH Batch.

- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE, may at its own discretion, waive the fees of students from economically weaker sections, provided the number of such students does not exceed 15% of total enrolment in the respective batch.

- v. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall ensure that no student shall be allowed to attend CPBH without paying the full fees except those permitted under sub-clause iv. above.

- vi. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit to FINESEV, before commencement of any batch, extracts of bank statement or copies of cash receipts or a letter from the Principal or Vice Principal confirming collection of fees from every participant.

7. Duration and contents of CPBI

- i. CPBI shall commence from May, 2021. The said Programme will involve training of about 100 hours.

- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to mobilize, on best effort basis, at least 40 students in first academic year and at least 60 students from second academic year onwards. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall decide the batch schedule and timings and inform the schedule to FINESEV at least 45 days before commencement of the batch.

- ii. INSSERV shall arrange to make the faculty available as per the schedule informed by the PARTNER INSTITUTE.
- iv. Detailed schedule of the lectures and practical shall be given in advance to students before commencement of CPBFI.

8. Place of teaching

- i. The CPBFI class room teaching and practical shall be conducted at Mugdha Gangadhar Mahavidyalaya the CPBFI Official Training Partner. For up to four hours a day on such days, dates and at such times as may be mutually decided between the parties.

9. Eligibility for CPBFI

- i. Any student who is studying in the final year of graduation Programme or pursuing any post graduation programme shall be eligible to apply for admission to CPBFI.
- ii. Additionally, any fresh graduate i.e. a graduate with less than 2 years of work experience or no work experience, shall also be eligible to apply for admission to CPBFI.
- iii. Only candidates who are less than 27 years old, on the date of application, are eligible to apply for admission to CPBFI.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall select the final list of candidates for admission based on the criteria mutually agreed upon by the PARTNER INSTITUTE and INSSERV from time to time.

10. Discipline and MISB to apply:

- i. The students of CPBFI-CLASSROOM and CPBFI-BLENDED shall be subject to rules of discipline/code of conduct of the PARTNER INSTITUTE during course period. In case of CPBFI – ONLINE, the students shall be subject to rules of discipline/code of conduct of the CPBFI Official Training Partner.
- ii. If the concerned CPBFI Official Training Partner observes a breach of code of conduct by any student, it shall immediately report the same to the CPBFI Coordinator for necessary action.
- iii. If any participant commits breach of code of conduct of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, the faculty shall have full authority to expel such student for the remaining duration of CPBFI.

11. Faculty

- i. INSSERV shall be solely responsible for arranging, through a CPBFI Official Training Partner, faculty, with requisite industry and teaching experience, and conducting CPBFI efficiently and effectively. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be responsible for making any payments to the faculty of the CPBFI Official Training Partner.

- ii. Some of the lectures of CPBFI may be conducted by the experts from INSSERV as per the understanding between the parties. However, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be liable to pay any amounts to INSSERV towards the said lectures and no amounts shall be deducted from the amounts payable to the PARTNER INSTITUTE.

12. Certification:

FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue a "Certificate of Completion" to "Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance" to the eligible students of CPBFI CLASSROOM and CPBFI BLNED. The certificates shall be printed by FINSERV and shall carry the logos of FINSERV, the PARTNER INSTITUTE and the concerned CPBFI Official Training Partner.

FINSERV shall issue a "Certificate of Completion" in "Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance" to the eligible students of CPBFI ONLINE. The certificates shall be in digital format and shall carry the logos of FINSERV, the PARTNER INSTITUTE and the concerned CPBFI Training Partner.

13. Further Agreements:

The parties agree that they may mutually discuss and enter into further agreements, if needed.

14. Confidentiality:

1. The Parties agree to maintain strict secrecy and confidentiality regarding any and all Confidential Information exchanged or to be exchanged between them in relation to this MOU.

2. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that all the course material provided by FINSERV or the CPBFI Official Training Partner, including but not limited to CPBFI structure, curriculum, lesson plans and evaluation methods, shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.

3. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that any of FINSERV's technical or business or other information including information given for development of any case studies / development of any program modules / contents, made available by FINSERV to its personnel to the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.

4. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to restrict access and disclosure of Confidential Information to such of their employees, agents, vendors, and contractors strictly on a "need to know" basis, to maintain confidentiality of the information disclosed to it in accordance with this clause.

5. Information and material disclosed and provided by each party to the other party in pursuance of or in connection with performance of its obligation under this MOU shall, at all times, remain the sole and exclusive property of the disclosing Party.

15. Intimation about cancellation/postponement of CPBFI:

6. If due to any cogent reasons, it appears to the PARTNER INSTITUTE that it is unable to arrange any batch as per schedule, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate about its inability to FINSERV at least 30 days in advance and the parties shall decide further schedule of CPBFI by mutual consent. FINSERV may decide to complete such batches through online classes.

7. However, if such postponement or cancellation is necessitated due to any bad minute, unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances like Act of God, civil commotion, strike, bandh, disruption of traffic, epidemic, war, aggression, change in Government Policy or any other similar circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate the change in schedule as early as possible after such circumstances as stated above have arisen. In such circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be held liable for payment towards any loss or damages caused to FINSERV due to delay in its schedule.

16. If for any reason, FINISRY, decides to discontinue support for CPMI, it shall give a written notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE, 30 days in advance. Such notice shall not impact any batch which is already in progress on the date of notice and the terms of this MOU shall continue to apply to the running batches.

15. Amendment/Termination

1. Any amendment to the terms of this MOU can only be made by mutual consent of the parties.
2. This MOU may be terminated by either party, for breach of terms and conditions of the present MOU or otherwise, by a written notice of at least one (1) month in advance. Such notice of termination shall not interfere with the batches underway at the relevant time. Such batches shall be allowed to continue until their conclusion.
3. Both the parties agree that Finisry shall have the right of terminating this MOU without any notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE if the PARTNER INSTITUTE charges a fee exceeding the amount prescribed under Clause 6(a) of this MOU. In such event, the batches underway at the relevant time, may also be terminated by FINISRY, unless the PARTNER INSTITUTE refunds the excess fee charged to every student of the batch.

17. Applicable Law and Dispute Settlement

1. This MOU shall be governed by the laws of India.

2. Any dispute arising between the parties in connection with or arising out of the performance of mutual obligations under this MOU shall be resolved by mutual discussion and consultation. If the dispute remained unresolved even after 30 days, then the dispute shall be referred to Principal, Magbena Gangadhar Mahendralakshya and Mr. V. Rajagopalan, President (Legal and Taxation), Bajaj Finserv Limited. The decision of Principal, Magbena Gangadhar Mahendralakshya and Mr. Rajagopalan shall be final and binding on both parties.

18. Others

This MOU is executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be original and retained by each of the Parties but together they shall constitute one and the same MOU.

Annexure 2: Methodology for Calculating Overall Attendance of the Batch

The steps and formula for calculating overall attendance are as under:

1. Enrollment: Number of students who have registered and paid fees for CPBFI
2. Drop outs: Number of students who dropped attending CPBFI during the batch
3. Regular students: Enrollment minus Drop Out
4. Total available student days: Number of regular students multiplied by total duration of CPBFI [number of days E.G. 40 days]
5. Actual student days: Sum of days attended by each regular student.
6. Overall attendance (%) = Actual Student Days / Available Student Days x 100

Example: In a CPBFI batch 43 students registered and paid fees. By end of first week 3 students dropped attending the batch. The batch was conducted for 40 days. Out of the 40 regular students - 10 attended every class, 15 attended for 35 days, 10 attended for 34 days and 5 attended for 30 days. Overall attendance will be calculated as under:

Enrollment: 43

Drop-out: 3

Regular students: 40

Available days: $40 \times 40 = 1600$

Actual days: $10 \times 40 + (15 \times 35) + (10 \times 34) + (5 \times 30) = 400 + 525 + 340 + 150 = 1405$

Overall attendance: $(1405 / 1600) \times 100 = 87.87\%$
