Disciplinary Action Policy for students

Each student is expected to follow the code of conduct and other college policies as listed on the college website. If a student engages in disruptive behaviour on campus or violates any college policies, they may face disciplinary action, which may include suspension or expulsion. The principal, the college's governing body, and the disciplinary action committee, which acts as the college disciplinary officer, oversee making decisions about the following kinds of punishment responses.

Students who are accused of misbehaving could face the following penalties.

Warning: a warning given orally to the student that their actions are against the student code of conduct and that they could face more disciplinary action if they continue.

Castigate: a formal warning about the infraction of the student code of conduct from the disciplinary action committee. Reprimands could involve the threat of harsher disciplinary measures if the student code of conduct is broken in the future.

Disciplinary probation: official written notification of a violation of the student code of conduct from the disciplinary action committee, which includes a ban from participating in certain events and places for a maximum of one calendar year.

Restitution: official action taken by the disciplinary officer to demand payment for property damage or improper use

Removal from classes/ facility: Expulsion of a student from a class, a facility, and/or the following class meeting or day due to the actions of a professor or administrator.

Before ordering the removal of any student from class, the teacher must give the students an oral notice of the reasons for the proposed removal or make a reasonable effort to do so. A teacher may remove a student from the classroom on the day of the incident.

Suspension: The disciplinary action committee's decision to prohibit the student from participating in any college programmes or events for a set amount of time.

Expulsion: The disciplinary action committee may expel students for good cause when other means of correction fail to bring about proper conduct.
