2. Various stylistic genres of Indian music: dhrupad, khayal, thumri, dadra, folk, rabindra sangeet, nazrulgeeti, geet, bhajan, ghazal.
3. Definition of taal along with knowledge of basic Hindustani and Rabindrik taals.
4. Notation systems of Indian music.
5. Notating Indian musical compositions and taal (chhotakhayal, Rabindra sangeet; Hindustani and Rabindrik taal –(one each))
