- 2. Various stylistic genres of Indian music: dhrupad, khayal, thumri, dadra, folk, rabindra sangeet, nazrulgeeti, geet, bhajan, ghazal.
- 3. Definition of taal along with knowledge of basic Hindustani and Rabindrik taals.
- 4. Notation systems of Indian music.
- 5. Notating Indian musical compositions and taal (chhotakhayal, Rabindra sangeet; Hindustani and Rabindrik taal –(one each)

Course content:

- 1. Alankars in different taals and layakari.
- 2. Basic Swaramalika, Lakshangeet, Chhotakhayal (1 each within the 10 Thaats).
