The year 2022 has been celebrated all over India as the 75th year of Indian Independence. HEIs were also participated in different level through various campaigns in this initiative. It is an initiative of the Government of India to celebrate and commemorate the glorious history of Indian Independence. Keeping in mind of this historic occasion the MHRD and UGC have jointly launched various programmes in order to extend collaborative campaigns and outreach programmes specially for schools and colleges of India. In connection with the above, the department of History of Mugberia Gangadhar Mahavidyalaya has taken an initiative to participate in the campaign and organized a one-day national integrity programme titled “**What will I do for National Integrity**” held on 13.08.2022 at S.N. Bose seminar Hall.

The programme started with lighting the holy lamp by the principal of the college, Dr. Swapan Kumar Misra. The programme coordinator was Prof. Sanatan Adhikary. In his inaugural speech Dr. Misra has delivered an excellent speech on Indian Secularism and integrity. He has elaborated the Idea of Bharatvarsha in a complex manner. Prof. Sanatan Adhikary, Assistant Professor of History, and coordinator has said, that students must have the idea of National Integration because it is the backbone of our democracy. He had also explained how the revolutionaries and freedom fighters have successfully uphold the National Integrity in the national movement and

successfully defeated the British. He also enunciated that the concept of National Integration is based on various parameters and one has to go deeper into the fact to understand how the complex relationship of caste creed and religious pluralism had developed national integration through ups and downs among the Indians widely located in the urge for free India movement and amidst socio-economic challenges.

Prof. Jyoti Mitra, Assistant Professor of Political Science, has delivered an important speech for the audience. According to him, the National Integration concept had been given priority after the constitution came into force. The Partition of India had a negative impact on the minds of the Indians, and thus it is necessary to go into the history of that period to identify how the people of India slowly accepted the regional integrity and showed respect to all the fragmented society and finally they have achieved the success. He observed that the preamble of Indian Constitution has to be studied by all to develop a clear conception of Indian Integrity. He described that Indian Constitution itself spoke about National Integration. India has a glorious past and it always upholds the National Integrity, however the British, in order to divide the unity of the Indians brought multiple reforms which are anti Indian and against the integration, however the people of India not only fought against the colonial approach of disintegration among the Indians but also upholds the practice till date.

Prof. Chandan Naru, Assistant Professor of Political Science delivered an excellent speech on how the prevailing casteism along with religious atrocities in India to a great extent became a barrier against the practice of National Integration. He said, before making any comment on the integration, we, the people of India must assert some fundamental idea that could curb the caste system as well as strictly believe in secularism. He also pointed out various social stigma which

are anti people and restrict people to upholds the National Integration in this large cosmopolitan territory.

Among the speaker, Sri Swapan Kumar Sasmal, Librarian, Dr. Alok Ranjan Khatua, Assistant Professor, Philosophy, Dr. Manoranjan Das, Associate Professor, Department of Sanskrit, Dr. Pintu Roy Choudhury have delivered speech on various parameters of National Integration and the role of the students. They have said that the students of UG and PG have always played vital role in consolidating people's voice all over India and they should not forget the fight fought by their ancestors. National Integration does imply the diversity in unity and thus all the students must respect others, their cultures, believes and with that India will become the strongest Nation among other countries.
