## 1. Introduction:

International Human Rights Day is observed or celebrated by the every country in the globe in every year on 10<sup>th</sup> December. The day is celebrated because, on the day 10<sup>th</sup> December in 1948 the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR). The Universal Declaration of Human Rights empowers us all. Human rights are in its nature both universal and inalienable; these are indivisible, interdependent and interrelated. At first, Thomas Hobbes (1588-1679) and John Locke (1632-1704) opened the concept human rights and they tried to establish this concept as fundamental human right such as right to property. After French Revolution (1789) the down fall of absolute monarchy and the rising of Aristocracy were the cause of *Constituent Assembly Formation*. The *Declaration of the Rights of Man and Citizen* (1789) which recommended the following legal claims:

1. Liberty: Man is free from his born.
2. Equality: Equal rights for all humans.
3. Fraternity: Fraternity for all humans.

These are the first opened dead of human rights in the world. The concept human rights was promoted as the enlighten concept of natural rights developed by the two philosophers – John Locke and Immanuel Kant. The original fact is that the ideas of *right* and *freedom* have entitled in the scope of human nature, and these ideas have been discussed in the domain of ethics and philosophy. It is, today, can be described as “human rights” in the modern sense. After violation of human rights in Second World War (no justice and no peace, but only destruction of humanity), “The Universal Declaration of Human Rights” was announced by UNO on 10<sup>th</sup> December, 1948 with 30 articles. This is the World Human Rights Day. Later, International Declaration of Human Rights with two covenants was announced by UNO on 16<sup>th</sup> Dec. 1966. Human rights define the rights and freedom to which all humans are entitled. Human rights, as we observe today, are known as the basic right of human beings, and these are considered as legal as well as moral claims of all people. We have rights in the sense that we have the opportunity to claim our demands which may be justified in legal and moral aspects. Human rights, as we regard today, can fight against the different social crises like discrimination (cast, race, gender, etc.) including reverse discrimination and inequality. Only human beings are entitled to human rights.

10 December 2023 marks the 75th anniversary of one of the world's most ground breaking global pledges: the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR). The Declaration was proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly in Paris on 10 December 1948 and sets out, for the first time, fundamental human rights to be universally protected. For observation of Human Rights Day, the United Nations has mentioned the theme of 2023 is “Freedom, Equality and Justice for All”. Therefore, we have selected the theme as the title of our one day seminar. The theme highlights the on-going struggle for equality (all human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights), it focuses justice for marginalised groups and individuals. The theme also demands human action to address human rights violations.
