





Effect on Oral Contraceptives Pills for Rural Female Health Status, Pataspur II Block Area

ABSTRACT

In family needs in everyday life; housekeeping and maintaining the home; and making clothes for the family—and who is not employed outside the home. A housewife may also be called a stay-at-home mother or "SAHM". In the present study a survey was conducted to compare health status between Consumer and Non consumer. The survey was carried out at Pataspur-II block area, Purba Medinipur, West Bengal. The data was collected for Consumer(n=15) and for Non consumer (n=15). A housewife is a woman whose occupation is running or managing her family's home caring for her children; buying, cooking, and storing food for the family. The survey was found that different measurements like height, weight, blood pressure, pulse rate, waist and hip circumferences, were carried out. The participants were asked about their hygienic condition and diseases. It was found that there was no significant (p>0.05) differences in body mass index, systolic pressure, pulse pressure, pulse rate, between Consumer and Non consumer. But it has noticed that waist hip ratio are significantly (p<0.05) higher in rural areas as compare to Non consumer. It was observed that more percentage of Consumer was suffering from Waekness, Hypertension, activenessas compare to Non consumer. It was found that more percentage of Consumer were hygienic is proper maintain from washing of hands after toilet and washing of cooking utensils compare to Non consumer.


