

## NOTICE

This is to notify that all the HOD/ In-charge of Undergraduate Courses are hereby informed to conduct the course of Community Services (CS) for Semester II (Major & Minor) under CCFUP, NEP, 2020 in their respective departments following the guidelines outlined below<sup>1</sup>.

- (i) Students to be provided with the opportunity of 'Community Service' within nearby locality, local bodies, local industry, business organizations, health and allied areas in 4 10 specific areas from the Annexure I below.
- (ii) As per the Regulations of the Vidyasagar University, in the 1<sup>st</sup> year (2<sup>nd</sup> Semester) of study, students shall be oriented to 4 Credits (Full Marks 50, Completely Based on Practical) Community Services course. Minimum 120 hours of engagement in NSS, Rural Development and Social Development activities in association with local governments (such as panchayats, municipalities etc.) under the supervision of a college faculty designated as Course Coordinator for Community Services.
- (iii) For the Community Services course, student shall be evaluated at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester by the Course Coordinator/ HOD/ Concerned authority following the Point Scale Activity Chart given in Annexture I.
- (iv) Photographic/ Audio-visual/ Documentation of work/ activity (Geo-tagged especially in case on electronic records) are to be recorded for evaluation/ assessment purpose in the respective departments under the jurisdiction of the respective heads.
